

**ROSE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
DECEMBER 13, 2010**

The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting on December 13, 2010. The meeting was opened by Supervisor Louis Mckellar with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 pm.

ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS: Present- Louis Mckellar, Carol Hanus, Russell Oyster, Kelli Collins and Linda Blair. Absent – None.

MINUTES: Minutes of the last regular meeting were read by Kelli Collins. Motion to accept the minutes as read by Linda Blair. Seconded by Russell Oyster. Motion voted and carried.

CORRESPONDENCE: A thank you letter was received for the contribution to the Rose City River walk.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Cemetery – Nothing new.

Collection Center – Oil bin is full and on hold to empty until spring.

Park – Nothing new.

Township Hall – Hannah Long has been contacted with dates for shoveling sidewalks at the hall. Kevin has fixed the tiles and in the kitchen and put mats down.

Fire Department- The fire department has cut down to one land-line telephone and the others are cell phones.

Roads – Louis advised there is a dispute with the property owners on N. Townline Road on where the road ends. There has been no word from the Road Commission on the sign for Reasner Road mystery spot. County Commissioner- Commission on Aging served 68000 home meals last year. They have purchased a new food truck. EMS on Airport Road has submitted a grant for a new generator.

CITIZEN COMMENTS:

Bonnie Zoia was present and inquired if she could get a discount rate for renting the hall for 6 weeks for an aerobic class she is going to do. The board discussed this issue and decided since it was a “for profit” class we would have to charge the listed price available to everyone. Motion by Carol Hanus to charge the listed rate for any “profit” entity renting the hall. Seconded by Russell Oyster. Motion voted and carried.

Bills were read in the amount of \$13,162.29 beginning with voucher number #12862 through voucher number #12894. Motion by Carol Hanus to pay all bills as read. Seconded by Russell Oyster. Motion voted and carried.

Louis advised the Board of Review meets tomorrow. Lucille McGregor has resigned and we are in need of another BOR member.
