UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Kangas stated Mark Benjamin is going to manage the paperwork for selling the townships vacant lot in Lupton. His fee will be between \$50-\$100. **Motion by Collins to sell parcel # 013-136-010-00 in Rose Township to Sheila Birchmeier for the amount of \$2,500. Second Kangas. Motion voted and carried.**

Bids were presented in sealed envelopes for the cemetery mowing, hall mowing and pavilion project. Supervisor Gemmill opened the envelopes. One bid received from The Yard Butler for mowing: Lanes Hgts Cemetery \$250 bi-weekly, Campbell cemetery \$120 bi-weekly, Spring/Fall cleanup \$200. Township Hall \$250 bi-weekly and \$100 Spring/Fall cleanup. **Motion by Maleski to award bid to The Yard Butler for mowing services. Second Kreiner. Motion voted and carried.**

One bid received for pavilion landscaping from D&C Landscaping. Labor, material and equipment \$2,225. **Motion by Maleski to award bid to D&C Landscaping. Second Kreiner. Motion voted and carried.**

NEW BUSINESS:

Gemmill presented the FY 21/22 Budget.

Collins stated the Fire Fund needs an amendment to the budget for 20/21. **Motion by Collins to amend the fire fund by \$200,000. Second Kreiner. Motion voted and carried.**

BILLS:

Bills were read by Collins in the amount of \$12,805.64 beginning with voucher number #30992 through voucher #31015.

Motion by Kangas to pay all bills as read. Second Maleski. Motion voted and carried.

Motion by Kreiner to adjourn the meeting at 7:47 pm. Second Maleski. Motion voted and carried.
