

**ROSE TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING  
JANUARY 11, 2010**

The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting on January 11, 2010. The meeting was opened by Supervisor Louis McKellar with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 p.m.

**ROLL CALL OF OFFICER:** Present- Louis McKellar, Carol Hanus, Russell Oyster, Kelli Collins and Linda Blair. Absent – None.

**MINUTES:** Minutes of the last regular meeting were read by Kelli Collins. Motion by Carol Hanus to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Linda Blair. Motion voted and carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Matt Bedtelyon, Whispering Hope Ranch Ministries, advised the board of 71 acres of property on Mayhew Road near his current property that they are purchasing for use by their Ranch. He asked the board's support to have it rezoned from CD to Agriculture. This property will have an indoor riding arena, used for grazing horses and farming the hay fields. Motion by Linda Blair to support Matt Bedtelyon (Whispering Hope Ranch Ministries) to have 71 acres of property on Mayhew Road that they are purchasing rezoned from CD to Agriculture. Seconded by Carol Hanus. Motion voted and carried.
