REGULAR MEETING

The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting on July 12, 2010. The meeting was opened by Supervisor Louis Mckellar with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS: Present- Louis Mckellar, Carol Hanus, Russell Oyster, Kelli Collins and Linda Blair. Absent – None.

MINUTES: Minutes of the last regular meeting were read by Kelli Collins. Motion by Carol Hanus to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Russell Oyster. Motion voted and carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Cemetery – Nothing new.

Collection Center – Doug Marlow was present and will ask his wife Linda if she is interested in making a sign for the collection center and cemetery.

Park – It was discussed we need to find an old lawnmower to pull the drag for the ball field. There are 15-18 lights out and we will order a case of replacement lights and hire someone to put them in. Hank will get a price for the diamond dust.
