

**ROSE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
JULY 12, 2021**

The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting July 12, 2021. Meeting was opened by Supervisor Aaron Gemmill with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 pm.

ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS: Present- Kelli Collins, Aaron Gemmill, Shelley Maleski, Amber Kreiner, April Kangas. Absent – None.

MINUTES: Minutes of the last regular meeting were approved. **Motion by Kangas to approve the minutes as presented. Second Kreiner. Motion voted and carried.**

CORRESPONDENCE: None.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Matt Jordan – Sting asked for the boards continued support. He stated 20% of their time is spent in Ogemaw County. **Motion by Collins to rescind motion dated November 9, 2020 opting out of Sting. Second Kangas. Motion voted and carried. Motion Kreiner to contract \$1,000 to Sting. Second Maleski. Motion voted and carried.**

Duane Prince was present to address public concerns on Gypsy Moth spraying. He presented an article “Addressing Forest insect outbreaks” to the board.

Mike Benefiel – M33 Access – offered his knowledge and guidance for extended broadband services under the Federal Relief Funding and explained how it can be used.

Complaints of blight on Oak Road were discussed. Gemmill explained he has talked to Ogemaw County and there is very little we can do to enforce blight violations.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Cemetery – nothing.

Collection Center – Maleski stated the collection center is non-stop on a regular basis. She has talked to Dawn at Republic and they are expected to issue a credit for our Free Dump Day due to them not providing the support and equipment expected.

Township Hall – Blue Flame Propane sent a contract for Pre-Buy at \$1.5999/gallon for 1800 gallons. **Motion by Kangas to pre-buy propane from Blue Flame at \$1.5999 for a total of 1,800 gallons. Second Maleski. Motion voted and carried.**

Fire Department – Nothing.

Roads – Campbell Road is done.

MTA – Nothing.

Litter and Zoning – Nothing.

County Commissioner – All meetings will be available through Zoom indefinitely along with public in-person. A resolution to increase commissioner terms from 2 to 4 years was submitted to the State. Ogemaw County received 4 million dollars from American Rescue Plan.
