PUBLIC COMMENT:

Tim Woelkers Director of New Life Camp stated they have purchased additional property. They spoke to County and verified it was ok to rename a county maintained road currently Long Road to New Life Drive. **Motion by Kreiner to approve renaming Long Road to New Life Drive. Second Kangas. Motion voted and carried.**

Gemmill presented a resolution to adopt poverty exemption income guidelines and asset test. **Motion by Collins to adopt this resolution as presented. Second Maleski. Motion voted and carried.**
