The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting November 12, 2018. Meeting was opened by Supervisor Russell Oyster with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 pm.

**MINUTES:** Minutes of the last regular meeting were read by Collins. **Motion by Blair to accept the minutes as read. Second by Hanus. Motion voted and carried.**

Cemetery - Oyster stated he has a couple of prospects for mowing cemeteries.

Township Hall - Blair stated she has set up an account with Arnold Sales for township hall supplies. Blair advised a past rental damaged the floor and it will need stripped and waxed. Discussion was held on hiring someone to strip and wax the entire hall. New cleaning person Sue LaFond has resigned. Tina Long was contacted and is willing to clean again and will let Blair know in the next couple of days.

Fire Department - Gemmill presented the Rose City Fire Board 2019 Budget. **Motion by Hanus to accept the 2019 Budget for the Rose City Fire Board as presented. Second by Blair. Motion voted and carried.** Gemmill advised the Public Hearing was held and Fire Chief Ron Vaughn was terminated.

Jeremie Brookins is acting Chief until one can be appointed.

Roads - John Copeland stated many of the township lights are out or not working correctly...especially concerned about the one on Rose City Road and Wangler Road. Collins advised lights can be reported not working or out by any person on-line at Consumers Website.

Rose Township Resolution on Senate Bill 396 - seasonal weight restrictions was discussed. **Motion by Oyster to oppose Senate Bill 396. Second by Gemmill. Motion voted and carried.**
