How to Request An Absent Voter Ballot-Your request for an absent voter ballot must be in writing by **MAILING** me the pre-printed form, a letter or postcard. After receiving your signed application, I will **MAIL** your absentee ballot.

Applications for absentee ballots can be obtained at the township hall located by the *front* office door in a box attached to the wall. If you wish to download an application go to rosetownship-mi.com and click the box for election information – this will take you to a link for requesting an application for absent voter ballots. If you would like me to **MAIL** you an application...please call, Kelli Collins at **989-685-3352 Monday through Friday** – leave a message and I will return your call. I make every reasonable request for an absent voter ballot achievable, but due to liability issues, we must enforce the above procedures recommended by the Department of State. If you are unsure if your summer tax bill has been paid, please call me. Unpaid summer tax bills, plus interest, are still payable to Rose Township until Feb. 28, 2013.

This tax season I will be collecting taxes at the Rose Township hall on two Saturdays in December & February. The hall is located at: 3380 Lupton Road in Lupton. Dates and hours are listed below.

The Township Hall will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on these Saturdays:

December 8th & 15th

February 9th & 23th

On Friday, Dec. 28th and Thursday, Feb. 28th the Township Hall will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Note: If there is inclement weather, please contact me at the hall to ensure that we are open. The phone number at the hall is 989-473-2001. If no answer, call 989-685-8047.

Thursday, Feb. 28th, 2013 This will be the last day to pay Summer & Winter Taxes at the Township. The Hall will be open 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. February 28th postmarks will also be honored.

On March 1, 2013 Penalty and interest applied to all unpaid taxes and are now due and **payable to the Ogemaw County Treasurer's Office in West Branch.** Their phone number is: 989-345-0084.



Dog Licenses will be available for purchase after December 1st. They can be purchased at the Township Hall on the scheduled tax collection days or from the Ogemaw County Treasurer's Office. **If you have received a license renewal form from the County, please bring it with you when purchasing new license.**

\$10.00 for Spayed/Neutered Dogs

\$15.00 for Male/Female Dogs

After March 1st, the license fee will be \$30.00 for all dogs and only available from the Ogemaw County Treasurer's Office. In order to issue you a license, we must see proof of a current rabies vaccination. Renewals can be accepted without rabies certificate if renewal form shows vaccination as current.
