West Branch Recycling

We would like to remind you that recycling is an available service to our residents. In order to recycle, just go to the West Branch City Hall and sign up. They will give you an identification card and a flyer with hours of operation and items accepted. They are currently accepting #1 & #2 plastics, glass, tin & aluminum containers, paper, magazines, newspaper and cardboard (clean).

Safety Notice

As we head into the season when it gets darker earlier, we thought it would be timely to remind our residents to make sure that their home's address is well marked.

Natural settings and long private driveways can make it difficult for police, fire and EMS personnel to locate residences in emergency situations. Numbers mounted to a home are not always adequate address signs. Address numbers should be a minimum of three-inches in height and should be clearly visible for the street. Reflective address signs are available from area retailers than can be attached to a mailbox post for even greater visibility.

Hopefully, you will never need an emergency response to your home, but when minutes count it is critical that police, fire and EMS personnel can find you.

Dec. 6th, 13th and 20th

Jan. 10th, 17th, 24th and 31st

Feb. 7th, 14th and 21st

On Dec. 27th and Feb. 28th the hall will be open between 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Hall will not be open on Jan. 3rd

Important Dates to Remember:

Feb. 28, 2008 Last day to pay Summer & Winter Taxes at the Township.

March 1, 2008 Penalty and interest applied to all unpaid taxes and are due/payable to the Ogemaw County Office.

Dog Licenses will be available after December 1st. They can be purchased at the Township Hall or from the Ogemaw County Treasurer's Office.

\$5.00 for Spayed/Neutered Dogs
\$10.00 for Male/Female Dogs

After Feb. 28th the license fee will be \$25.00 for all dogs and only available from the Ogemaw County Treasurer's Office.

In order to issue you a license, we must see proof of current rabies vaccination.
