

ROSE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
SEPTEMBER 13, 2010

The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting on September 13, 2010. The meeting was opened by Supervisor Louis Mckellar with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 pm.

ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS: Present – Louis Mckellar, Carol Hanus, Russell Oyster, Linda Blair and Kelli Collins. Absent – None.

MINUTES: Minutes of the last regular meeting were read by Kelli Collins. Motion by Linda Blair to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Carol Hanus. Motion voted and carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Cemetery – Nothing new.

Collection Center – The oil bin is full – Russell will someone to dump it. A recycle center at our collection center was suggested – Russell will get information on that.

Park – Only 4 bulbs were burned out at the park – it was discovered that someone had turned the breakers off at the poles. The bathrooms are ready to be winterized. Doug Marlow has agreed to paint the bathrooms in the spring for hourly maintenance wages. Motion by Linda Blair to hire Doug Marlow to paint the bathrooms at the park next spring. Seconded by Carol Hanus. Motion voted and carried.

Township Hall – The railing on the Gazebo is broken – Kevin Hanus will fix it

Fire Department – Russell advised Cummings Township is going to contract again with Lupton for fire protection.

Roads – Heath Road construction has begun. The “mystery spot” on Reasner Road was again discussed concerning the extra traffic – it was suggested to contact the county and have signs posted “no parking”.

County Commissioner – Bruce Reetz stated the Master Gardner program was put back in the budget another year for \$12000.00. Security at the court house voted against only using 1 entrance for the building. The jail inspection passed – the fire marshall may allow the jail to open next week.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Red Cross sent a letter and agreement asking for our hall to be designated as an emergency site.

Motion by Russell Oyster to allow Red Cross to use the township hall as an emergency site. Seconded by Linda Blair. Motion voted and carried.

A letter from our attorney was received advising the people who didn't get their letters on the alley abandonment will be published in the paper.

The Road Commission is having their annual bus tour on October 13, 2010.

Kelli presented a pre-buy contract from Fick and Sons for propane for the 2010/11 winter season at \$1.69 per gallon. Motion by Kelli Collins to pre-buy propane at \$1.69 for 2010/11 winter season. Seconded by Linda Blair. Motion voted and carried.

BILLS:

Bills were read in the amount of \$18,325.97, beginning with voucher number #12772 through voucher number #12803. Motion by Carol Hanus to pay all bills as read. Seconded by Russell Oyster. Motion voted and carried.

Motion by Russell Oyster to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 pm. Seconded by Carol Hanus. Motion voted and carried.
