The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting September 10, 2012. Meeting was opened by Supervisor Louis Mckellar with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 pm.

**ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS:**

**MINUTES:**

Minutes of the last regular meeting were read by Kelli Collins. Motion by Carol Hanus to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Russell Oyster. Motion voted and carried.

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Letter from attorney Brabant advising rate increase from \$125.00 to \$175.00/hour beginning January 2013.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

*Cemetery* – Nothing new.

*Collection Center* – Louis talked to the attorney about non-residents bringing trash to the collection center. He advised we form a committee to make “rules” for the collection center and then enforce them. Several people suggested we make a sign in list and everyone must sign each time they visit the collection center. Several other area collection centers do it this way.

*Park* – Nothing.

*Township Hall* – Hacht has installed a new water heater for \$600.00. Leah will take care of the ant problem this month. Coffell Builders have not gotten back with us for a price on the door yet. Linda will contact John Mitchell to trim the trees in the patio area.

*Fire Department* – Budget workshop is scheduled for September 26. Kelli gave Russell a copy of a fire run which was declined from Consumers Power – Russell will check into it.

*Roads* – Residents want a sign on Reasner Road for farm equipment – Louis will check with the county.

*Litter and Zoning* – Louis said he talked to attorney on the fireworks complaints. He suggested could have our enforcement officer enforce an ordinance if we chose. Russell suggested we avoid this and just have residents call 911 as a noise disturbance.

*Library* – Marsha advised they need volunteers to help with homework. Skidway library is moving forward and they are opening bids on September 14.

*County Commissioner* – Bruce advised the fracking meeting was very good. They passed a motion to put the \$1.00 surcharge on the ballot for 911. Crawford County is pulling out of Sting program.
