Ogemaw Transit has received grants for 4 new buses and office improvements. Missy Mayhew has been hired to replace Oswald in Equalization. The auction for the Neeley property profited of \$18,000 which will be used to pay restitution. Judge Noble requested to only allow one entrance to the County Building and all others locked.
