

**ROSE TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 13, 2021**

The Rose Township Board held their regular meeting September 13, 2021. Meeting was opened by Supervisor Shelley Maleski with the pledge to the flag at 7:00 pm.

**ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS:** Present- Kelli Collins, Clifford Esmond, Shelley Maleski, Amber Kreiner, April Kangas. Absent – None.

**MINUTES:** Minutes of the last meeting and Special meeting were approved. **Motion by Kangas to approve the regular meeting minutes and special meeting minutes as presented. Second Kreiner. Motion voted and carried.**

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Nothing.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

Cemetery – Kreiner stated Lane Heights drive washed out from storms and gravel was hauled in.

Collection Center – Esmond stated we need a new sign for pricing. Chris Roth will do it while working. Fees were discussed with possible increase. It was discussed to possibly charge for recycle. Dean Mayhew stated many residents of Hill Township are trying to use our collection center. It was discussed to check into new cards for residents.

Township Hall – Kreiner asked about getting bids for the Pavilion area as the cement is heaving again. Brenda Butler will do the maintenance work at the hall.

Fire Department – Nothing.

Roads – Dyer Road was discussed. Pat Reinke from the Road Commission advised the latest PASER numbers of this would show it would benefit from an overlay. The cost would be 50/50 which would make the township share approximately \$30,000. Maleski will check into it more and we will revisit next month.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Collins advised Randy Booth from Equalization made a mistake in the rollback fraction on our L-4029 form. He has sent us a new amended form to adopt and sign. **Motion by Collins to approve the amended L-4029 Tax Rate Request for 2021 as presented. Second Maleski. Motion voted and carried.**

Collins updated everyone on the Rifle River Outlet Drain Drainage District from the August 30 meeting in Arenac County. No action was taken as the mailing service did not notice everyone in the district in Ogemaw County and they will resend those letters. They are planning another hearing at a later date in a couple of months. Hopefully this will be in Ogemaw County.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Jerry Fischer presented pictures and a map of a blighted property at 570 Circle Drive. Blight officers Dean Coleman has sent 2 letters previously with no response. The board explained we have no authority to enforce blight and no longer have a blight ordinance as we were also unable to enforce that. Mr. Fischer asked if the board would write a letter to the property owner. Maleski stated she will get with Dean and see if there is anything else to be done. Collins suggested adjacent property owners could contact the owner and volunteer to mow/clean up the area if the owner is unable/unwilling to do it?

Kangas stated the annual Pumpkin Bash in Rose City is scheduled for October 9, 2021. They again are asking for a contractual contribution. **Motion by Maleski to make a contractual contribution of \$750 for the 2021 Pumpkin Bash. Second Kreiner. Motion voted and carried.**

Maleski advised the Homecoming Parade will be in Rose City on September 17, 2021.

**BILLS:**

Bills were read in the amount of \$27,423.42 beginning with voucher number #31209 through voucher number #31230. **Motion by Kangas to pay all bills as read. Second Esmond. Motion voted and carried.**
